Dear Council,

Please approve DC-3, Resolution to Rescind R-19-139 (Community Engagement and Approval Processes for City Related Improvement Projects).

The "projects" that R-19-139 refers to are lane conversions, also known as road diets. They are a well-documented engineering practice of eliminating measurably underutilized traffic lanes in order to improve safety for drivers and pedestrians. Research shows that wider roads cause faster driving and grave threats to crossing pedestrians. Done correctly, lane conversions slow the peak speeds of cars and vastly improve pedestrian and driver safety, without significantly impacting traffic throughput.

R-19-139 created two new processes—triggered whenever city engineers proposed implementing a specific lane conversion—that required staff to 1) facilitate resident meetings and surveys about the proposed change, and 2) seek City Council approval for the specific project.

In my view, the passage of R-19-139 almost two years ago marked one of the low points of City Council decision making in recent memory:

It ran afoul of City Council's core function as a policy-making body by injecting politics into highly-technical decisions, specifically ones that are based in a robust community-created plan like the transportation plan. For example, we have a policy of delivering clean drinking water, but we don't debate our engineers about the size of water mains. Likewise, we committed to a Vision Zero policy on pedestrian deaths, so we shouldn't reject staff advice about the width of roads or subject decisions to a straw poll of nearby residents.

The process that arose from R-19-139 allowed the subsequent political rejection of a road safety improvement on Earhart Road, a low-cost project that staff found would have virtually eliminated crashes (see chart). This is a documented safety hazard in my neighborhood being perpetuated by politics.

R-19-139 cynically created additional layers of public and political process—not focused on values or goals, but about the implementation of specific neighborhood lane conversions. I say "cynically" because despite the favorable outcome of a public survey about the Earhart Road conversion, City Council still voted it down.

I ask that you continue to be bold in your leadership. We are dealing with multiple crises in our city. One crisis is the senseless deaths and injuries of drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians. Every unnecessary delay in addressing them means unnecessary suffering. By all means,

continue to ask questions and challenge staff, but please accelerate processes and policies that have been proven to work in other communities. Rescinding R-19-139 is just one small step in hastening safety improvements for all residents.
