2. <u>09-0553</u> Discussion of Conservation Easement Terms

Peg Kohring presented a slide presentation to the commission regarding the Conservation Easement Terms. The presentation gave a review and the history of the easement language. It also talked about new easements and whether or not GAC should consider a new easement for non-FRPP properties; and local food needs vs RFPP terms. Ms. Kohring recommended creating a subcommittee to help understand what the current easements are; to provide recommendations on non-FRPP row crop agriculture easements; survey other land trusts and provide recommendations on easement terms to the commission.

3. <u>09-0554</u> Staff Updates

Ms. Trocchio informed the commission that they've worked with the Communications Intern to revise the website. They would like to add pictures to site and a professional photographer working with the Parks Department will take pictures for the website. She showed samples of the work done by the photographer for the Parks Department.

She added that the Greenbelt website is one of the top 10 most visited webpage on the city's website. Residents can sign up for email alerts for news coming up regarding the Greenbelt on the city's home page.

Ms. Trocchio passed out brochures on the Food system Economic Partnership Conference scheduled for June 18, 2009. More information is available on line if commissioners are interested in attending.

Commissioner Bloomer asked for an update on the signs with Preserve Washtenaw.
