PROPOSAL: The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has been advised by Mr. Paul Drobnik, Manager, Ypsilanti System Support Center, of his request to decommission the Jackson (JXN) Outer Marker (OM) and JASKO Locator Outer Marker (LOM), at the Jackson County Airport-Reynolds Field, Jackson, Michigan. The facility is no longer needed to maintain the National Airspace System (NAS) due to the current runway realignment project. Should the study show that the decommissioning the JXN OM and JASKO LOM would not be detrimental to the NAS, the device will be removed without replacement.
