DEAR SIR/MS :

I AM AN 80 YEAR OLD BALMORAL PARK RESIDENT WHOSE RESIDENCE IS IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO OAKBROOK DRIVE AND DIRECTLY ACROSS FROM THE CURRENT ANN ARBOR DOG DAYCARE FACILITY.

PRESENTLY AT THIS FACILITY, DOGS BARK AND HOWL VERY LOUDLY FOR AN EXTENDED TIME, ALMOST WITHOUT INTERRUPTION, THROUGHOUT THE DAY. THIS NOISE NUISANCE IS EXTREMELY DISLOVEATING AND ANNOYING, AND IT WILL ONLY INCREASE UNDER THE PROPOSED EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A MAXIMUM OF 125 DOGS ON SITE.
