As part of Comcast's commitment to keep you informed about important developments that affect our customers in your community, I am writing to notify you of a change in the channel lineup and pay-per-view pricing.

Effective December 31, 2007, NOGGIN and The N networks will separate into two 24-hour services (currently they share time on channel 131). As part of this change, Nick GAS (Games and Sports) will go dark and The N will replace Nick GAS on channel 133. Noggin will remain on channel 131. Customers will be notified by bill message.

Customers will also receive the following bill message regarding pay-per-view Video ON DEMAND pricing:

As part of our continuing effort to keep you informed about your Comcast Cable Services, we are writing to notify you of an upcoming price change. Effective February 1, 2008, the prices for some pay-per-view movie releases are changing. The price for "New Releases" will increase from \$3.99 to \$4.99 and the price for IFC in Theaters movie titles will increase from \$5.99 to \$6.99.
