## WS-1 City Council Annual Retreat and Goal Setting Session

City Councilmembers participated in the annual retreat and goal setting session at the Wheeler Center. Staff provided reports, discussed the City's financial forecast for the next two years and helped Council establish its priorities.

Councilmembers agreed on three main priorities for the City:

- Complete the master plan updates: the Ann Arbor Discovering Downtown (A2D2) initiative; area height and placement amendments and zoning initiatives.
- Pursue economic stability for the city by considering a city income tax and developing an economic development strategy.
- Improve customer service by increasing effectiveness of communicating about service delivery, recognizing modes of communication are changing.
