The City Attorney is appointed by the City Council and performs all legal services for the City, including legal advice to City Officials, preparation and review of contracts and other legal documents, prosecution of persons accused of violating City ordinances, and representation of the City and City officials in lawsuits. The City Attorney's Office does not provide legal advice to members of the public.

CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE – HORIZON ISSUES

- Finance and Information Technologies: Smart Cities work, expansion of the I-Net Fiber Network, Contract Management issues, taxation and funding issues, streamline electronic systems
- Community Services: Continued development of more difficult sites, development ordinance amendments (floodplains, short term rentals, parking, sustainability, etc.), ordinances and programs to increase affordable housing, increased enforcement, increased prosecution issues and marijuana establishments, increased building code compliance efforts
- Public Services: Energy/Environmental/IT related (Right of Way) issues
- Human Resources: New initiatives in HR including new director, numerous retirements in city, training efforts and policies
- Safety Services: More training for AAPD, ICPOC issues
- Sustainability: Carbon Neutrality, Solar Projects
