I have lived for forty-one years at 1911 Lorraine Place which is just a few homes from the house in question.


The letter from the attorneys for the Petitioner states that the group will include students. Students are explicitly excluded by the city code.

While the Ann Arbor Jesuit Community is part of an old established religious group, any group of people may form a religion. Will the city then start deciding which group ^{is a} religion and therefore a functional family?

If this exception is granted, who will assume the responsibility to monitor and enforce its limits?

Since this neighborhood has a large number of multi-bedroom homes, I fear that the character of my neighborhood may be permanently changed by this precedent. Therefore, I am opposed to the granting of this special exception use.
