My name is Lisa Wondrash and I'm the Communications Director for the City of Ann Arbor and the Cable Communications Commission (CCC) staff liaison. I wanted to welcome you to the Commission, provide upcoming meeting dates and CCC bylaws.

The Cable Commission meets quarterly at CTN on the first Wednesday of the month in February, May, August and November. **Our next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 1 at 3 p.m. at CTN, located at 2805 S.
