- Automated traffic enforcement is illegal in Michigan.

• Oppose contracting third-party stakeholders for automated traffic enforcement.

- Discuss vehicular level of service.
- Increased funding for non-motorized projects.
- Leadwalk installations at The Ride's expense.
- Right-of-way plans With adjacent land use, TC-1.
- High pedestrian activity attention and potential improvements.
