We are writing to offer our unqualified support for the Jesuit community in Ann Arbor in their quest to live on Wayne St. We have been neighbors of these men since they moved onto Ferdon. They are gentle, quiet, kind, friendly, warm neighbors, and the residents surrounding the home in question should have no concerns about these men. They are ideal neighbors.

They are also good for Ann Arbor, ministering to students and permanent residents, working for social justice and the poor, and providing an educated set of leaders for the local Catholic community and for many non-Catholics.

We strongly urge that you permit these men to live together and to make the requisite exception to what is of course a reasonable rule for the neighborhood. This exception, we are confident, will have no negative effect on the neighborhood. Likely the opposite.

We also urge you, if possible, to postpone the item of business until after the June meeting in order to enable a fuller participation of more members of your commission.
