Outdoor Swimming Pools Presentation on 2010 Season

- **J. Straw** gave an overview of the three outdoor pools and explained programs offered, service improvements and the participation...

- J. Straw stated the pools had a very successful season this year and complimented the staff.

Argo Reconstruction – TSP Environmental and City Staff

- **J. Lawter** asked how long the reconstruction would take to complete.

G. Lacy stated if construction began in the winter of 2010 there is a possibility of completion by summer of 2011. **S. Offen** asked about the consequences of doing nothing. **C. Smith** stated the stop-log would stay in place for the foreseeable future.

T. Berla asked why removing the Dam is not an option in the Consent Agreement.

S. Bahl stated the MDNRE doesn't advocate for dam removal, and the concern was the repair of the embankment.

J. Grand pointed out that PAC didn't request that dam removal be considered as an option.

D. Barrett asked S. Bahl if the embankment was safe and secure.

S. Bahl stated the MDNRE is not concerned with the safety of the concrete portion of the Dam and staff is monitoring the embankment and that it has been stable.

M. Anglin asked why the Water Fund was proposed to cover some costs of the project.

S. Bahl stated because it had been budgeted that way – and that Council would need to give direction not to do that.

D. Barrett inquired about the Va hydro feasibility study.

M. Wade responded the VA had shared their report with City staff, but that staff were not sure how the VA intended to proceed.

Whereas, Staff issued bids for toe drain repairs and an RFP for the reconstruction of the headrace embankment;

Whereas, Staff and the Selection Committee evaluated submitted bids proposals;

Whereas, Staff and the Selection Committee selected TSP Environmental to design and construct a by-pass channel in the Argo Dam headrace; and

Whereas, Funding for the project is available from the Park Rehabilitation and Development Millage and Water Fund.

- **J. Lawter** suggested an amendment to the language in the Resolution, recommending the whitewater feature be added for an additional \$180,000.

- **S.** Offen expressed concern regarding monies being spent for adding the whitewater feature and would prefer to see monies be spent in various parks where there is a greater need.
- **J. Lawter** explained his reasons for suggesting the amendment pertaining to the whitewater feature, also stating how this feature could possibly be an asset to the City.
- **J. Grand** asked why the selection committee didn't include whitewater in the recommendation.
- **C. Smith** explained the whitewater wasn't included as it was beyond the scope and exceeded the requirements of the Consent Agreement.
- **J. Grand** shared the amended resolution with the commission and asked for a roll-call vote.
