## **Notable Variances:**

- Revenue overall is higher than budgeted which is mainly the result of the
   Continuum of Care program revenue being over budget. The funding of the
   Continuum of Care program is largely pass-through funding which means that
   the expenses for the program are also higher than budget.
- Total **Administrative Expenses** are below budget due to lower administrative salaries which are lower due to year-end accruals & 2 vacancies
- Total Housing Assistance Payments are higher than budgeted for Continuum of Care due to delayed grant execution by HUD & retroacive payment

## **Net Operating Income**

\* Net loss overall is higher than budgeted and is primarily from Section 8.

The revenue for the program was lower than the Housing Assistance as well as administrative fee payments received from HUD.
