Re: Historic Signs

I've put together draft historic sign language for your review. This is a first attempt, and likely to change, but I'd like you to review it to make sure the intent seems reasonable. Once all commissioners have had a chance to nominate their own possible signs, I'll put together a powerpoint presentation for a future meeting.

To be placed somewhere within **Nonconforming Signs** in Chapter 61 of City Code

Signs of local historic significance. The City Council may approve and or amend a list of existing non-conforming signs deemed to be of local historic significance by the Historic District Commission. Signs deemed historically significant may be repaired or reconstructed, or relocated within the same site if the new location is less nonconforming. Historically significant signs may be altered to reflect a change in business, but alterations that result in a loss of historic significance as determined by the Historic District Commission may be removed from the list by City Council.
