

CITY OF ANN ARBOR ELECTION COMMISSION
October 13, 2009 MINUTES

The City of Ann Arbor Election Commission Meeting was called to order by the City Clerk, Jacqueline Beaudry, at 3:07 p.m., in the City Hall Council Workroom, 100 N. Fifth Avenue, Ann Arbor, MI, 48104.

The members present were City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry and City Attorney Stephen Postema. Police Chief Barnett Jones was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Postema moved to approve the minutes of the September 1, 2009 meeting with a correction to the attendance showing that Postema arrived late, not absent. Beaudry seconded the motion and the motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

The following resolution was offered by Postema and supported by Beaudry:

RESOLVED, That the list of proposed election inspectors by the City Clerk's Office be appointed for the November 3, 2009 City General Election in the City of Ann Arbor.

On a voice vote, the Chair declared the motion carried unanimously with two members present.

INFORMATION

University of Michigan Residence Halls – polling places

Clerk Beaudry updated the Commission regarding the use of the residence halls at the University of Michigan for polling places. The University is currently looking for alternative sites for the City to use for campus polling sites as they have security concerns regarding the continued use of the residence halls. This change could affect polling places at Bursley Hall, Mary Markley, East Quad and South Quad.

It was decided that the Commission would meet again to discuss this issue when more details were available.
