## STATEMENT OF WORK EXECUTIVE POLICY ADVISOR FOR NEIGHBORHOOD ENGAGEMENT/TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

Formulate and pursue strategies intended to develop a strong network of neighborhood associations and civic groups empowered to engage with City staff in matters related to transportation safety and neighborhood quality of life.

Work with the City Administrator to move forward the following FY2019 priorities for neighborhood engagement and transportation safety:

- Develop and actively participate in the formation and conduct of a Vision Zero Task Force that supports implementation and reporting on the recommendations of the Transportation Commission's Speed Reduction Committee.
- Assist in the development and review of processes that advance or impede development and construction of safe and people friendly streets and expansion of the urban trail network.
- Coordinate with City staff on these and other matters related to neighborhood engagement and transportation safety.
- Attend conferences and meetings as discussed and approved to advance understanding of key neighborhood safety and transportation safety issues.
