I was 8 yrs old when I became the racial target of hate like the Arizona Law will promote and encourage. I saw my brother and 2 little cousins killed just because they were brown skin in the wrong place. I was the only one who barely survived that day in 1964 because a brave young white male decided to stop the hate. I am alive today because he did the right thing and stop the chain of hate. He stood up for humanity. I came thru the racial back doors of college and became a nurse because I wanted to know why humans allowed so much hate around them. I wanted to know if I a person of color was human. All I found to this day has been humanity in the rainbow of human colors. Humans hate because they want too, not because they have too. It is an easy way out of feeling strong in the inner self to target some one else and allowed all that hate to take control.

I am a proud Latina American. Not a criminal, but a nurse. At times many of us are afraid to go outside our homes because when the racist does not get us the police, Homeland security etc will. Being Latino in modern day America is a crime. Arizona has put out a video on "How to catch a Latino in Arizona". No not dogs, but Latinos like me.

Recently I attempted to pay my respect to my childhood hero Ernie Harwell at Detroit Tiger Comerica Park I was pushed around by Tiger Comerica security padded down and searched. My crime was I showed up dark skin Hispanic in a "sea of white people". They security opened my bag and touched me over my pockets. I was told by security that "I was different" "they needed to search me now" I was the only one searched in line. I was laughed at by whites along with the security staff. They called racial names and told "me to go back to where hell I can from." AMERICA?

I am an American citizen who has been beaten by my Nursing managers and removed from my job as a nurse in front of patients and coworkers on what the employers called "Clean up wetbacks" "Puerto Rican Niggers" day at work. I am an American. Not a criminal but a nurse. I am afraid to go outside my home. I fear my ethnicity will get me beaten or killed.

I live in America. Not China or Nazi Germany in 1947 etc. The members of the Ann Arbor City Council have to decide what side of humanity to stand on as they consider the resolution to boycott the racist Arizona Laws today. The Arizona racist law will harm many children and families not only in Arizona but across this nation. Hate kills and if you survive it. You will never be the same. Broken for life. One just learn to live aside the the painful nightmare of hate and just pass thru time to finish another day. Hate harm the target and their haters for years to come. The chain of hate can harm a generation for years to come. The Arizona racist Law will harm many, many of us Latino Americans across this nation. Only you can stop the chain of hate and save a life. In 1964 a brave white young man stop the chain of hate and saved my life. Please pass it on. You can do it. Boycott the racial chain from Arizona.
