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- The Michigan Public Service Commission will hold a public hearing to consider The Detroit Edison Company's March 8, 2010 application to amend its Energy Optimization Plan.

On March 4, 2009, The Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) filed its application seeking approval of its Energy Optimization Plan, as directed by the Michigan Public Service Commission's (Commission) December 4, 2008 order in Case No. U-15800. The Commission issued an order on June 2, 2009 approving the company's proposed Energy Optimization Plan.

On March 8, 2010, Detroit Edison filed an application to amend its Energy Optimization Plan to provide additional energy optimization opportunities to its customers. Detroit Edison also requests approval of additional surcharge revenue designed to recover the costs of the plan.

Detroit Edison is seeking approval of an Energy Optimization Plan beginning June 2010 and ending December 31, 2015 which is for a period of longer duration than that currently approved by the Commission. The company proposes to recover additional annual Energy Optimization Plan cost recovery in the amount up to \$32.1 million in 2010, \$55.5 million in 2011 \$68.7 million in 2012, \$68.1 million in 2013, \$67.6 million in 2014, and \$67.5 million in 2015 through implementation of maximum energy optimization surcharges, and other related accounting and regulatory approvals. The Company proposes maximum energy optimization surcharges in place of those currently charged to customers for Detroit Edison's Energy Optimization Plan for each customer class as follows:

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing on April 19, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his/her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.

Requests for adjournment must be made pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure R 460.17315 and R 460.17335. Requests for further information on adjournment should be directed to (517) 241-6060.
