Jane Immonen- non-profit organization wants to preserve genetic material for champion trees. Greenhouse operation to clone champion trees. They do not sell the trees- they do have Giant Sequoia for sale that are \$5000 per tree. They mostly fundraise and you can buy hats, t-shirts, etc. Benzie county area to plant the trees out. As the organization grows they may be more willing to plant in other areas. Warren Attarian will contact the organization to see if they can plant trees in Ann Arbor.
