



2019 Tentative Street Treatment Projects



Pavement Markings

Approximate Budgets for FY20/21:

- ▶ Major Street Fund: \$370K
- ▶ Local Street Fund: \$52K
- ▶ ALT Fund: \$245K




Translates Into

Approximately:

- ▶ 37 miles of long line remarking
- ▶ 14 miles of bike lane remarking
- ▶ 375 intersections remarked

Road Funding Projections




Major and Local Street Fund

Where the increased funding is planned to be spent:

- ▶ Contracted spray patching/potholes
- ▶ Increased Capital Maintenance
- ▶ Pedestrian Safety Enhancements
- ▶ Senior Transportation Engineer – 1.0 FTE

Allen Creek Berm Opening


- ▶ Easements obtained & plans submitted to MDOT

- ▶ Construction in 2019 from July - November
- ▶ Work will likely be completed in spring 2020



Argo Dam




