

**AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO
RENEWAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
WATERTAP, INC.
AND
THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR**

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, with offices at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, Michigan 48107-8647 ("City") and Watertap, Inc., with offices at 56720 McKenzie Lane, South Lyon, Michigan 48178 ("Contractor"), having entered into a contract dated October 14, 2013, for the provision of Water Main Line Stops and Insertion Valves (Bid No. ITB-4309) for a three-year period ending June 30, 2016, with options to renew for three additional one-year periods, and the City and Contractor having agreed by renewal agreement dated June 15, 2016 ("Renewal Agreement"), to renew the contract for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, agree to amend the Renewal Agreement as follows:

- 1) Paragraph 3 of the Renewal Agreement is amended to read as follows:

For the renewal period July 1, 2016, though June 30, 2017, City shall pay the Contractor the unit prices as given in the Bid Forms of the original agreement and approved contract change orders for an estimated total of Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000.00) per year for the services to be provided under this renewal agreement. Contractor to submit invoices as required under the original agreement. Payments subject to approval of the Contract Administrator.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties dated October 14, 2013, as renewed by Renewal Agreement dated June 15, 2016, unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this amendment and are made a part of this amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This amendment to the agreement between the parties, as renewed, shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
