Parks Department Responsibilities

Facilities Management will be responsible for twice yearly – March and October – cleaning of all the exhibits, both glass frames and porcelain wall images. There are 23 frames and xx wall images. Historic Preservation Coordinator's Responsibilities

1. Remind Parks Department staff about twice-annual cleaning (as above). Notify the Program Coordinator.
2. Refer small maintenance issues to the current Program Coordinator, who will take care of the matter.
3. Refer replacements to the current Program Coordinator. **There will be no cost to the city** (unless the city is responsible for destroying or damaging an exhibit). The Program has an endowment to take care of replacement.
4. Refer general historical questions to the Ann Arbor District Library staff, currently **Amy Cantu, (Productions Librarian, 734-327-4242, cantua@aadl.org)** and the caller notified of the website. Questions regarding the program will be referred to the current Program Coordinator.

Historic District Commission Responsibilities

The Commission will serve to keep an eye on the program. Whenever one of the Commissioners sees anything in the Exhibit that needs attention, he/she will immediately tell the Historic Preservation Coordinator who will follow up as necessary.
