My name is Larry Eiler and I live at 4712 Breezewood Court in Ann Arbor. I am writing in support of the Jesuits' petition to receive a special exception use so that they can live at 1919 Wayne Street. I am a business leader, teacher and author and have resided in Ann Arbor since 1980. Our seven children have been educated in Ann Arbor Public Schools and some of them at the University of Michigan and Eastern Michigan University.

I have known the Jesuits for more than 40 years in Ann Arbor and Rochester, NY, where I was for six years chair of the board of the Jesuit and student community at St. John Fisher College. I believe they would not only be good neighbors but also continue to contribute to the well being of Ann Arbor as they have for the past 10 years through their ministries at St. Mary's Student Parish with the 2,000 members of the parish.
