

## **Ann Arbor Municipal Airport** **Security Gate Access Code Change Notice**

In an effort to maintain reasonable levels of security at the Ann Arbor Municipal Airport, the security gate access codes to the three hangar areas will be changing. The gate access codes have not changed in many years and too many individuals no longer associated with the airport still have access to these secure areas. As airport management, we need to make sure these access codes are changed from time to time. As airport tenants, being diligent in gate control is important. This includes keeping gate access codes secure, escorting visitors and passengers in secure areas and being diligent that gates are closed before you leave the gate access areas.

It benefits us all to ensure that unauthorized and unfamiliar individuals stay outside of these secure areas. This helps lessen the risk of runway incursions, which can jeopardize our user's safety. It also helps maintain secure hangar facilities, which protects your aircraft and other belongings.

**Beginning March 27, 2019, gates #1 and #2A that access the NW T hangar area will now have the gate access code # [REDACTED]. Gates #3 and #4 that access the NE T hangar area will now have the gate access code # [REDACTED]. Gate #5 that accesses the State Road hangar area will now have the gate access code # [REDACTED]. If you have a sub-tenant(s), please provide them the new code and the following requests.**

- Please do not provide the access code to others. Locked gates provide additional protection for your aircraft, airport property and operations and keep out vehicles and pedestrians unfamiliar with the airport.
- If you have a guest meeting you at the airport, please meet them at the gate and escort them to your hangar.
- Finally, once you have driven through the gate, please stop and wait for the gate to close.
