The Design Review Board discussed your revised design for 321 North

Main Street on February 21, 2018. Please consider the following comments and recommendations made by the Board when preparing a future site plan petition:

- 1. Note some Board members felt the massing organization seemed counterintuitive as the taller entry structure is on the far side of the building from the downtown core and the lower entry structure is on the near side.*
- 2. Note the Board was conflicted on the proposed color scheme. Some felt it was appropriate while others felt the Kerrytown character district is more colorful than the proposed muted earthtones.*
- 3. Consider eliminating, or simplifying, the architectural element outlining the retail entry door. Also, do include the cut and etched panels mentioned as under consideration.*
- 4. Consider enlarging the windows at the corners of the building on the third, fourth and fifth floors so they are as tall as the windows on the sixth floor.*
- 5. Note some Board members felt the blue cornice line was detracting from the overall design plan.*
