Current Infield Conditions

- Poorly Graded
 - Lip at edge of infield
- Poor Drainage
 - Water is held on the infield limiting play
- Deficient Material
 - Material creates dust in the summer and does not dry quickly after rain

Current Outfield Conditions

- Uneven Playing Surface
 - Low and high spots create a safety hazard
- Poor Turf Condition
- Warning Tracks
 - Improper material and filled with weeds
 - Lip between warning track and outfield
- No Automated Irrigation (Vets and West Parks)

Proposed Improvements

- Regrade Infields to Provide Positive Drainage
 - Remove Infield Lip
 - Replace Existing Infield Material
 - Install Drainage around the Perimeter of the Infield
- Replace Fencing
- Automated Irrigation
- Concrete Dugouts and Bleacher Pads
- Field Turf Restoration
