221 Felch Street Rezoning and Area Plan - A request to rezone this 2 acres site from M1 (Industrial) to R4D (Multiple-Family Residential) and a proposed area plan for the potential redevelopment of this site if rezoned. All existing structures in the floodway may be removed and a 51-unit apartment building with covered and surface parking, as well as all other required site improvements, may be developed. 2250 Ann Arbor-Saline Road Annexation, Zoning and Site Plan - A proposal to annex this vacant 5.34 acre parcel from Pittsfield Township, zone it R4B (Multiple-Family Dwelling District) and construct one building containing 75 dwelling units, exercise room, community room and indoor pool. The units will be a mix of one (20), two (53) and three (2) bedroom units. The proposal includes constructing 84 exterior parking spaces and 70 parking spaces under the structure. A storm water detention basin will be located in the rear of the site. The basin will be oversized to accommodate additional offsite water runoff from the north. (Ward 4) Staff Recommendation: Approval
