NEW BUSINESS

- Community Foundation -

- Be it resolved: The Ann Arbor Public Art Commission recommends that the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation carry over to 2017 the 2016 distribution amount from the Ann Arbor Art in Public Places Endowed Fund totaling \$920.61. (Kotarski)

- TR-OT-15-02 - South University Streetscape (E Univ. to Washtenaw)

- Be it resolved: The Ann Arbor Public Art Commission recommends that the South University Streetscape project (TR-OT-15-02) be enhanced because it is a both an important link and well traveled by residents, students and visitors. The enhancement should contribute to place making opportunities through the use of street furniture, wayfinding, sculptures, sidewalk embellishment, street embellishment or design elements determined by the task force. A budget of \$15,000 to \$45,000 is recommended. (Rizzolo-Brown / Smith)

- TR-AT-16-04 - Non-Motorized Connection under E Medical Center Dr Along S Side of Fuller

- Be it resolved: The Ann Arbor Public Art Commission recommends that the Non-Motorized Connection at Fuller under the East Medical Center (TR-AT-16-04) should be enhanced to improve the experience and safety of its use. The enhancement should elevate the experience through creative and artful use of lighting, applied graphics, installations or other design elements as determined by the task force. A budget of \$25,000 to \$50,000 is recommended. (Rizzolo-Brown / Smith)

OLD BUSINESS

Market, Parks and Engineering staff met to plan the project design. The dedication is set for August 6th, time TBD. Marsha has communicated with the Jewett family and all are

onboard for the dedication. August 6th is the 97th Anniversary of the Market and will offer other festivities, onsite food vendors and activities.

The temporary site preparation will consist of new concrete slabs, removal of current bench and adding additional planting materials. Remaining budget should cover site preparation, design, printing and mailing of the postcard invitations. PA system and water to be supplied by the city.

A more detailed project plan will be developed and disseminated to all interested parties.
