9-a 20-0566 Valhalla Ann Arbor Site Plan, Annexation, and Rezoning for City Council Approval - Proposed multiple-family residential project containing 454 units and townhomes with parking located under the buildings and along the private drives. Project includes annexation of parcels from Pittsfield Township and petitioner is requesting a conditional R4E multiple-family zoning designation of this 9.8-acre site, located at 31-163 Valhalla Drive and 2065, 2099 South Main Street. **Requesting Postponement**

- **9-b** 20-0567 <u>Greenhills School Track & Field Site Plan and Landscape Modification for</u> <u>Planning Commission Approval</u> - The petitioner proposes to remove and replace the track and field facilities. The 6-lane track will be replaced with an 8-lane track while the grass infield will be replaced by artificial turf. A new storm water detention system is proposed underneath the infield. The petitioner is requesting a landscape modification for this 30.49-acre site located at 850 Greenhills Drive, zoned Single-Family (R1-B). Staff Recommendation: Approval

Prior to the construction of a new single family home, the petitioner will need to remove the existing home on the site. Staff Recommendation: Approval

This will result in a total of 9 replacement being planted on-site and 10 replacement trees being planted in the adjacent lawn extensions. The site plan was originally approved in 2019 for this1.63-acre parcel, zoned Business Service (C2B). Staff Recommendation: Approval
