## F HUD CHANGES TO SECTION 214 - PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

HUD is proposing a Rule that would amend Section 214 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1980. Section 214 prohibits the Secretary of HUD from providing financial assistance to anyone other than United States citizens or specific categories of eligible noncitizens in HUD's public and specified assisted housing programs. HUD's Public Comment Period for this proposed rule ends July 9, 2019. Staff want to make the HHSAB aware of the policy change and comment period. HHSAB has an opportunity to prepare a written response to submit to HUD by the July 9th deadline for public comment.
