C COORDINATED FUNDING - ANY LIMITATIONS ON USE?

Staff reviewed the formal agreements that have historically been in place with the Coordinated Funding partners (Memorandum of Understanding and annual resolutions) Neither document requires that the City's funding be limited to use restricted to use for city residents and/or city non-profits. As a reminder, the Ann Arbor Affordable Housing Fund policy document does allow for those funds to be spent outside of the City limits. "The City has a priority on using Affordable Housing Fund dollars on projects within the

City limits, but will allow for Fund dollars to be used outside the City limits."

Draft Motion:

Whereas the Washtenaw Coordinated f=Funders are intending to review their practices to place more of a focus on addressing issues related to race, poverty and trauma as a whole, and

Whereas the Affordable Housing Fund includes policy that allows for City funds to be utilized outside of the City's limits,

Be it Resolved that the Housing and Human Services Advisory Board recommends the City Council all Coordinated Funding contributions not be limited to grantees located and/or serving City of Ann Arbor Residents

Be it further resolved that the HHSAB supports refocusing the Washtenaw Coordinated Funders efforts toward addressing issues related to race, poverty and trauma
