NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO REZONE MSGCU PROPERTY (2151 WEST STADIUM BOULEVARD)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 20, 2020 to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-20-04 — MSGCU Property. This ordinance would rezone 0.6 acre from C2B (Business Service District) to C3 (Fringe Commercial District), located at 2151 W. Stadium Boulevard.

The proposal would amend the City Zoning Map, which is a part of Section 5:10.2 of Chapter 55, Title V of the Ann Arbor City Code.

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5:10.2 of Chapter 55 of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Chapter 55, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHW-EST CORNER OF SECTION 30, TOWN 2 SOUTH, RANGE 6 EAST; THENCE NORTH 854.1 FEET; THENCE NORTH 75 DEGREES 48 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 743.10 FEE; THENCE SOUTH 01 DEGREES 56 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 451.29 FEET FOR A POINT OF BE-GINNING; THENCE NORTH 65 DE-GREES 10 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 150.49 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 00 DEGREES 03 MINUTES 00 SECONDS WEST 11.02 FEET; THENCE NORTH 65 DEGREES 10 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 173.96 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 64 DEGREES 50 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST 140.00 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 65 DE-GREES 50 MINUTES 00 SECONDS WEST 383.29 FEET; THENCE NORTH 01 DEGREES 56 MINUTES 00 SECONDS WEST 162.97 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
