## TRAFFIC ADOPTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE CODE AND UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10:1a OF CHAPTER 126 (TRAFFIC) OF TITLE X OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The City of Ann Arbor Ordains:

Section 1. That Section 10:1a of Chapter 126 of Title X of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor be amended to read as follows:

10:1a. Adoption of Michigan Vehicle Code and Michigan Uniform Traffic Code.

(1) \_\_\_\_\_\_Effective May 1, 2005 January 1, 2011, the City of Ann Arbor adopts by reference the Michigan Vehicle Code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923 and as subsequently amended, except for MCL 257.627, 257.628, and 257.629. A complete copy of the code is available to the public for inspection in the Office of the Ann Arbor City Clerk.

(2) Effective January 1, 2011, the City of Ann Arbor adopts by reference the Michigan Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages, R 28.1001 et seq., of the Michigan Administrative Code and as subsequently amended. A complete copy of the code is available to the public for inspection in the Office of the Ann Arbor City Clerk.

(23) The penalties provided by the Michigan  $\frac{\sqrt{2}}{\sqrt{2}}$  ehicle e<u>C</u>ode <u>and Michigan</u> <u>Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages</u> are adopted by reference, provided, however, that no ordinance violation <u>under the Michigan Vehicle Code</u> shall be punishable by more than 93 days imprisonment.

(34) The provisions of the Michigan <u>V</u>ehicle <u>eC</u>ode <u>and Michigan Uniform</u> <u>Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages</u> adopted in this section supersede all provisions of this chapter that substantially correspond to provisions in the Michigan Vehicle Code <u>or the Michigan Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages,</u> <u>respectively.</u>, except for Sections 10:44, 10:45, 10:46, 10:47, and 10:48.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day following legal publication.
