## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing on the following items will be held by the Ann Arbor City Planning Commission on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

Proposed Amendments to Ann Arbor City Code Chapter 55 – Unified Development Code – Amendments are being considered to the Unified Development Code (UDC), Section 5.22 Storm Water Management and Soil Erosion, Paragraph 5.22.3 Storm Water Management Systems, to eliminate currently offered exceptions and revise the criteria for approving alternative standards. Removing the exceptions when no additional impervious surface is proposed, when new impervious area is for ADA compliance or public sidewalk, or when existing impervious surface is an historic structure, will make the Section more consistent with the Rules of the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner and maintain compliance with federal and state regulations. Changing the alternative method of storm water detention would allow more flexibility when constraints make it infeasible to meet the full detention volume requirement.
