## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING 530 N. DIVISION PUD ZONING (530 N. DIVISION ST.)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m., Monday, February 6, 2023 in the City Hall Council Chamber, 2nd floor of the Guy C. Larcom, Jr. Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-23-01 – 530 N. Division Zoning. This ordinance would rezone 0.19 Acres from R4C (Multiple-Family Dwelling District) to PUD (Planned Unit Development District), 530 N. Division Street Zoning and Supplemental Regulations at 530 N. Lot 10, Block 24, Ormsby and Page's Addition to the City of Ann Arbor, as recorded in Liber M of Deeds, Page 191, Washtenaw County Records; except the Westerly 33 feet as sold to the City of Ann Arbor by deed recorded in Liber 124, Page 107, Washtenaw County Records.

in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan as PUD (Planned Unit Development District).

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after ten days from legal publication.
