The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct public hearings at 7:00 p.m., Monday, December 18, 2023, in the City Hall Council Chamber, 2nd floor of the Guy C. Larcom, Jr. Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-23-34 – 2520 & 2540 Pontiac Trail Rezoning, and related site plan for The Villages.
