#### Call to Order:

Chairperson Leslie Stambaugh called the meeting to order and Alicia Thomas, Human Resources, recorded the minutes. A quorum of Committee members was present, and the meeting, having been duly convened, was ready to proceed with business.

#### **Matters Discussed:**

- 1. The specific wording of the proposed Video Privacy Ordinance was discussed and the wording was altered as needed. It was noted that the Commissioners Elyakin and Winkler, who could not be at this meeting, were supportive of the spirit of this proposal.
