I currently serve the Ann Arbor Public School District (AAPS) as its Interim Superintendent of Schools.

I have been informed by several community members and others that the Transportation Safety Committee, in the past, has recommended a crosswalk and adjacent sidewalks in the area near Martin Luther King Elementary School (King).

I understand that there is currently a mid-block crosswalk for our students and other pedestrians. The King School walk zone has been expanded to include the Geddes Lake community resulting in an increase of our student pedestrians.

AAPS has worked collaboratively with the City to improve pedestrian transportation safety in school walk zones and I am writing to ask you to support this project as recommended by the Transportation Safety Committee.
