Dear Mayor Hieftje and members of the Ann Arbor City Council:

We write to you on behalf of the Ann Arbor/Ypsilanti (A2Y) Regional Chamber and its 1,200 plus members to express support for Ypsilanti Township's efforts to join the Ann Arbor Area Transportation Authority, or "The Ride." We are hopeful you will approve this effort at your November 18th, 2013 meeting.

Regionalism, coordination and cooperation have long been hallmarks of the A2Y Chamber's advocacy efforts. The Chamber believes that Ypsilanti Township's inclusion in The Ride represents a very positive development towards further regional transit collaboration. This is especially relevant since the City of Ypsilanti joined The Ride earlier this year. Questions remain regarding the proposed five year plan that AAATA is advocating for, along with how best to configure governance of the future Ride Board.
