Jack

When you review the SCIO Sidewalk issue tonight, PLEASE seek ways to combine both the new Sidewalk at SCIO near I-94 WITH one of the Storm Water Impoundments recommended by the Upper Mallets CAC.

From a CONSTRUCTION standpoint, it makes sense to excavate SOME of the impoundment area NOW and use the spoils to build up the sidewalk "cliff" area that currently exists.

Page 52 of the final Upper Mallets Study states:

Lawton cost: \$5.15 million
Pioneer cost \$1.17 million

The EISENHOWER PARK ABUTS THE SCIO NEW SIDEWALK:

COST: \$2.1 million

Bill Higgins told me that the SCIO SIDEWALK is proposed as \$180,000 +/-.

NOW IS THE TIME TO COORDINATE THESE 2 PROJECTS AND GAIN SOME ECONOMIES OF SCALE.

IT IS POSSIBLE TO DO ONE NORTHERN PHASE OF THE UPPER MALLETS WORK NOW TO HELP REDUCE THE COSTS OF BOTH PROJECTS.
