Washtenaw County OCED has solicited proposals from consultants to complete an update to the 2007 Affordable Housing Needs Assessment. Goals for this update include an analysis that links transportation to the location of affordable housing, the identification of policies and goals by sub-areas to guide decision making and resource allocation, as well as numeric targets of a wide range of affordable housing types.

Eight proposals have been received for this work, ranging in cost from \$60,000 - \$172,000. It is requested that the HHSAB consider support of this work through use of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. While OCED is still in the process of selecting a consultant, additional support for this study is being requested.

Proposed Motion:

The Housing and Human Service Advisory Board recommends use of up to \$37,500 from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund in support of this Assessment.
