As a member of St. Mary Student Parish and the grateful beneficiary of the wisdom and service of their Jesuit community I am requesting your approval of their request for house more than four members in the home they wish to purchase in Ann Arbor Hills. I can understand and accept the reluctance of some to this approval.

will probably be in residence for far greater than 3-4 years. This will not be a cult--far different personalities, interests and again the varying ages, talents and scholarly backgrounds.
