Public Housing Resident Application for Work

The AAHC is rehabilitating its properties and the AAHC is required by HUD to hire public housing residents whenever feasible to comply with federal Section 3 regulations. HUD's Section 3 program encourages PHAs to promote resident jobs by allowing PHAs to give job hiring preferences to Public Housing residents. In addition, contractors are required, "to the greatest extent feasible," to hire public housing residents when contracting with public housing authorities.

Work will be offered to public housing residents with a preference for residents that meet the following:

- Age 18 or older
- Have not received a Notice to Quit or Lease Non-Compliance Notice in the past 6 months
- Rent is current or current on Repayment Agreement

Examples of potential jobs: Assist disabled and elderly tenants with packing, construction-related jobs, AAHC property and grounds cleaning, landscaping, food service.
