ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSION
TAXICAB BOARD

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1:207 OF CHAPTER 8, ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF TITLE I OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The City of Ann Arbor Ordains:

Section 1: That Section 1:207, Taxicab Board, of Chapter 8, of Title of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor be amended to read as follows:

1: 207. Taxicab Board.

(1) The Taxicab Board shall consist of 5 voting members who shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the City Council. One of the voting members shall be a member of the City Council. The other 4 members shall not be officers or employees of the city. The ~~Chief Financial Officer~~City Administrator's designee and Chief of Police, or his designee, shall be nonvoting board members.

(2) The term of the Councilmember shall be 1 year. The term of the other 4 voting members shall be 3 years. ~~All terms shall expire on the second Monday in April.~~ If a person ceases to be a member prior to the end of the term of appointment, a replacement shall be appointed by the ~~m~~Mayor for the remainder of the original term.

(3) The ~~Chief Financial Officer~~City Administrator's designee shall serve as secretary of the board. The board shall elect its own Chairman ~~each April~~ who shall serve for a term of 1 year.

(4) The Taxicab Board shall have the powers and duties described in Chapter 85 of this Code.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day following legal publication.
