Operations

- New Assistant Market Manager, Liz Kellam, has officially begun training. Liz will be responsible for Wednesday Evening Market Operations in 2015. She will be introduced at the May 21, 2015 PMAC meeting when she presents the season overview for the 2015 Wednesday Evening Market.
