Looking for artists to submit designs for the tank. Contest Rules, Judging Criteria and artist Submittal process are yet to be determined. Tentative deadline date for all submittals is June 1, 2015. Brian will reach out to the local community for judge/panel members.

Canoe Imaging Art Foundation Budget Estimates - Our engineering consultant, Glen Wiczorek, P.E. says that current estimates are conservative and may be higher than what was anticipated. (6) possible pieces and all will require a foundation and excavation work. Location of these pieces will be key and are yet to be determined. Commission has a desire to be as transparent as possible with the community throughout this process. Appreciation shared for the work of The Arts Alliance. Suggestion to raise private funds; these pieces will have a significant impact and

become part of the permanent landscape of the City.

Ann Arbor Bridges Project - Resolution to appropriate \$40,000 for the installation on the March 2nd Council agenda. Commission members are welcome to attend.

Jewett Project. - Work continues to reach the goal; City cannot move forward without the funding.
