COMMUNICATIONS FROM STAFF

Mayer of Munich - Erica Behrens of Mayer of Munich are art consultants who specializing in working with painters, conceptual artists and pair with fabricators on stain glass, mosaic, ceramic, etc. pieces. Artist received projects or apply for projects and artist selected by committees. Ideal is if design early and set parameters and site her company can work with them throughout the entire process. They look to develop and work with new artist in close collaboration to maintain the highest artistic and quality standards.

Mayor Gallery Space in Council Chambers - The new gallery space is located on the east wall and is approximately 24 feet in length. City staff currently working together along with Omari Rush of the Ann Arbor Art Center to finalize and discuss the necessary lighting and rail placement for pieces. Once the recommendations for lighting and the hanging rail are established staff will move forward with pricing information, ordering the equipment, finding the electrician and installing the equipment.
