New Public Art donation form has been completed and is available online. Commission wishes to experiment with donations and put these two pieces within the community. No cost, liability covered by Nissan Family, a permanent donation as part of the City in collaboration with DDA. Discussion re location of these two pieces and a great deal of support from community. These two pieces received the Art Prize award in Grand Rapids.

Concerns raised re public outreach for donated art. Commission has provided public input and outreach for all art within the City. Donated pieces should be treated the same. Process for these two pieces should allow for engagement of the city, neighborhoods and the community. Commission will set a donation sub committee that will work to set guidelines, processes and procedures to be sure that all donations to the Clty are transparent.
