# RESOLUTION TO CONSOLIDATE PRECINCTS FOR THE CITY PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2007

Whereas, The City of Ann Arbor has determined that a local Election will be held in the City of Ann Arbor on Tuesday, November 6, 2007;

Whereas, The City of Ann Arbor has determined that precinct consolidation would be appropriate for this election because of an anticipated low voter turnout; and

Whereas, Eight polling locations have two precincts, within the same ward, located in the building for each site that could easily be consolidated causing minimal inconvenience to the voters; and

RESOLVED, That the City of Ann Arbor Election Commission hereby directs the City Clerk to conduct said City General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2007 by consolidating the following precincts for this election only, recognizing that consolidation is possible without splitting any precincts or relocating any voters from their usual polling location:

- 1-1 and 1-2 Michigan Union
- 1-5 and 1-6 Northside School
- 2-3 and 2-4 Angell School
- 3-1 and 3-2 East Quad
- 3-4 and 3-7 Allen School
- 3-6 and 3-9 Scarlett Middle School
- 4-4 and 4-8 Pioneer High School
- 5-4 and 5-5 Slauson Middle School

On a voice vote, the Chair declared the motion carried unanimously.
