Mr. Westerman motioned to approve July 20, 2016 meeting minutes; **Mr. Wortman seconded the motion.** Committee unanimously approved.

Information item #1: FY 16 & FY 17 Dean Fund Budget Reports & Project Status Update

Project Update:

- Vesper Project- Trees did not get planted, moved project to fall 2016. Tree Pruning \$5,337.51, went over budget for the pruning. There are still 4 crabapple trees that need to be planted at a cost of approximately \$1,300.
- **Triangle Neighborhood- Trees planted.** Planted 23 trees and ground several stumps in the neighborhood in early May.
- Scarlett Middle School Trees planted. Planted 2 trees for Arbor Day/Earth Day with students from Scarlett Middle School on April 29, 2016.
- Citizen Pruner Program- Tool and supplies purchased. The following tools and supplies were purchased: (10) Corona 7" Folding saws, (10) Barnel long handle saws, (20) Fiskar bypass pruners, (20) Pocket Diameter tapes, (5) Standard Diameter tapes, 5 Mesh bags for hard hat and vest storage.
- Watering Dean Promenade. Completed for June. Watering will continue through the summer.

Discussion Item #1: Review Previously funded projects and Dean Promenade Plans

Committee reviewed list of previously funded projects.

The Dean Promenade plans that staff found were not the original construction plans. Staff will see if the original plans can be found and will bring to a future meeting.

Discussion Item #2: Project Ideas FY17

- Maple Road (Stadium Blvd to Scio Church) October Tour
 - 50 vacant planting sites.
- S. Main Street just south of William October Tour
 - 10-12 remove and replace Zelkovas have a conversation with DDA about locations- is there an
 opportunity to work with them on this project.
 - Baker Commons- needs help, too.
- iPads for Citizen Pruner program (\$1,600/year) 5 iPads-\$8000
 - o Committee members would like staff to see if Apple would donate iPads.
- Tree watering intern \$7,000/intern
 - Committee would like to keep this on the project plan for this year, but will consider specific funding at a future meeting.
 - City has a 300-500 gallon water tank but staff are looking into whether there is a pick-up truck available to put the watering tank on.
- Dean Promenade on Main Street.
 - Replacement of Honeylocust that was removed this summer and removal and replacement of small dead Ginkgo that was planted several years ago. Approximate cost of \$1,500.
 - 2.5"-3" Honeylocust (need to remove the stump and all or most of the soil in the planting pit to eliminate the concern about any decay organisms that might be in the soil.
 - 2.5"-3" Ginkgo
 - Committee asked if there was additional work that needs to be completed in the Dean Promenade. Staff responded that there is no work that requires immediate attention.

Mr. Westerman motioned to approve \$1,500 for the replacement of the Honeylocust and the removal and replacement of the Ginkgo in the Dean Promenade. Mr. Wortman seconded. Committee unanimously approved.

- Slauson Middle School Arbor Day/Earth Day tree planting event in spring
 - City staff will be working with a teacher at Slauson to coordinate. Details to come at a future meeting.

Ms. Immonen adjourned the meeting at 10:26 a.m.
